Instant application has been filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”) filed by the respondent titled as “Balkar Ram vs. Manipreeth Kaur” (Annexure P/1), pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Jalandhar to the court of competent jurisdiction at S.B.S. Nagar.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that respondent has no objection if the case filed by him under Section 13 of the Act is transferred to S.B.S. Nagar.

In view of consent of both the parties, petition under Section 13 of the Act filed by the respondent titled “Balkar Ram vs. Manipreeth Kaur”, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Jalandhar, is withdrawn and
