Instant petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed seeking transfer of petition titled ' Shubam Ghai @ Saleem vs. Pinki', filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, 'the Act') for restitution of conjugal rites, from Family Court, S.B.S.Nagar to Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the applicant contends that respondent has filed a petition under Section 9 of the Act pending in the Court of learned Family Court, Judge, S.B.S.Nagar. Now applicant is residing with her parents at Kartarpur which is far away from S.B.S.Nagar and it

is very difficult for the applicant to attend the court proceedings on every date. Therefore, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending at S.B.S.Nagar may be transferred to the competent Court at Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the respondent, after seeking instructions from the respondent, states that he has no objection if the case filed by respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Act is transferred to Jalandhar.

Without going into the merits of the case, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, request is allowed. Petition under Section 9 of the Act pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, S.B.S.Nagar is ordered to be transferred to learned District Judge, Jalandhar, who may assign the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction there. Learned District Judge, S.B.S.Nagar shall ensure that entire record of the case is sent to learned District Judge, Jalandhar. The parties through their learned counsel are directed to appear before learned District Judge, Jalandhar on 15.02.2016.
