Delay

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the judgments of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in Imrat Lal and others vs Land Acquisition Collector and others 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437 and Dhiraj Singh (D) Tr. LRs. vs Haryana State and others 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 507, delay of 362 days in filing the Review Applications is condoned. However, for the period of delay in filing the Review Applications, the applicant(s) shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation, if any.

CMs stand disposed of.

Review Applications

Learned counsel for the parties are agreed that the issues raised in the present Review Applications have already been decided by this Court vide order dated 21.11.2016 passed in RA-RF No. 173/CI of 2016 in RFA No. 3520 of 2006 – Bhim Singh and others vs State of Haryana and another.

For the detailed reasons recorded in Bhim Singh's case (supra), the present Review Applications are disposed of in the same terms. However, the landowner(s) shall not be entitled to interest, if any, for the period of delay in filing the review applications i.e. 362 days.
