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The review-applicant seeks to recall the order dated August 25, 2015, whereby Division Bench of this Court dismissed the Letters Patent Appeal filed by the review applicant against termination of his services on the post of Granthi, as he was found to have misconducted by entering into illegal possession of Gurudwara.

We have gone through the contents of review application, which is nothing but an attempt to re-argue the case on merit. It is claimed that Gurudwara property was taken into illegal possession by someone else and not the review applicant. We are afraid that no such plea was taken or proved before the Bench. That apart, such a plea ought to have been taken by the appellant in reply to the charge-sheet. It is relevant to mention that writ petition was filed after delay of six years and was dismissed on that count alone. In the Letters Patent Appeal also, no such factual plea was taken or agitated. There is otherwise no merit in this review application.

That apart there is delay of 376 days in filing the review application. The vague plea taken is that review applicant was not in possession of certain important documents which he has now been able to procure with great efforts. The averments being totally vague and evasive,

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the review application as well as application for condonation of delay is dismissed.
