No material has been produced to establish that she is legally wedded wife of Late L/NK. Hira Lal (No. 2487899-N). In the absence of necessary material to demonstrate that she is a legally wedded wife, appellant is not entitled for any relief in the present appeal.

Hence RSA is dismissed.

Dismissal of RSA would not come in the way of appellant to approach trial Court seeking necessary relief like obtaining declaration that she is a legally wedded wife of late L/NK Hira Lal (No. 2487899-N).
