This review application seeks to recall the order dated 27.08.2015 whereby a Co-ordinate Bench dismissed the Letters Patent Appeal filed by the review applicant/appellant-Corporation. The appeal is accompanied with an application for condonation of delay of 355 days in filing the appeal.

Having heard learned counsel for the review-applicant at a considerable length and it appears to us that the Review Application is liable to be dismissed on two counts. Firstly, there is a delay of 355 days in its filing. Though attempt has been made to explain the same but we do not find any convincing or reasonable explanation to condone the delay of almost one year. Application is accordingly rejected.

Secondly, on merits also, no error on the face of the record is pointed out. Learned counsel has re-argued the case on merits. Assuming that the second view is possible, yet it will not amount to be a valid ground to entertain the review.

The application seeking condonation of delay of 355 days as well as the Review Application are thus dismissed.
