By filing the present application, the applicant seeks review of order dated 21.03.2016 passed by this Court vide which the present petition was dismissed.

After hearing learned counsel for the applicants, this Court is of the considered view that the present review deserves to be dismissed as under the guise of present application, learned counsel for the applicants intends to re-argue the matter by taking the same pleas which were earlier raised by him and dealt-with in the order dated 21.03.2016. Such a view was taken by Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in **Dalbir Singh Lochab and others Vs. State of Haryana and others** 2014(1) RCR (Civil) 115. More so, the revision petition was dismissed vide order dated 21.03.2016 after hearing learned counsel for the applicants-petitioners.

I do not find any illegality in the order passed which may warrant any interference in the present review application. Consequently the Review Application stands dismissed.
