By filing the present application, the petitioner-applicant seeks review of order dated 15.02.2016 passed by this Court vide which Civil Revision No. 6995 of 2015 filed by the applicants, was dismissed.

After hearing learned counsel for the applicants, this Court is of the considered view that under the garb of present application, learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner intends to re-argue the matter by taking the same pleas which were earlier raised by him and dealt with in the order dated 15.02.2016. The main revision petition was dismissed after hearing learned counsel for the parties. The present review application is totally misconceived as it was categorically mentioned in the order that the litigation has already attained finality and even the objections filed by the applicants-petitioners were dismissed and the Revision Petition filed by them bearing CR-7113-2014 was also dismissed vide order dated

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16.10.2014. I do not find any illegality in the order passed which may warrant any interference in the present review application. Consequently the Review Application stands dismissed.
