Applicant-wife, by way of instant application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeks transfer of a divorce petition filed by the respondent-husband from Bhiwani to Panchkula.

Notice of motion was issued.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

During the course of hearing, it has transpired that applicant-wife is working at Gurgaon and respondent-husband is staying at Secunderabad.

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that in view of the changed circumstances, let the divorce petition filed by the respondent-husband at Bhiwani may be ordered to be transferred to Gurgaon instead of Panchkula.

In view of the above-said common stand taken by the learned counsel for the parties, the present transfer application is allowed and the divorce petition filed by the respondent-husband is ordered to be transferred from Bhiwani to Gurgaon.

Accordingly, learned District Judge, Bhiwani, is directed to send the complete record of the divorce petition to the learned District Judge, Gurgaon, at an early date.

Learned District Judge, Gurgaon, is also directed either to decide the case himself or assign it to the learned court of competent jurisdiction for its early decision, in accordance with law.

Parties are directed to appear before the learned District Judge, Gurgaon, on 23.5.2016.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, the instant transfer application stands disposed of.
