SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

By filing the present application, the applicant seeks review of order dated 11.02.2016 passed by this Court vide which the present petition was disposed of.

After hearing learned counsel for the applicant, this Court is of the considered view that the present review deserves to be dismissed as under the guise of present application, learned counsel for the applicant intends to re-argue the matter by taking the same pleas which were earlier raised by him and dealt-with in the order dated 11.02.2016. Such a view was taken by Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in **Dalbir Singh Lochab and others Vs. State of Haryana and others 2014(1) RCR (Civil) 115**. More so, the revision petition was disposed of vide order dated 11.02.2016 and the matter was remanded to the Court below to decide the same afresh after hearing both the parties and after getting the calculation from them. The Court below was directed to decide the matter in terms of judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in **Gurpreet Singh Vs. Union of India 2008(2) R.C.R. (Civil) 2089 (SC)**.

I do not find any illegality in the order passed which may warrant any interference in the present review application. Consequently the Review Application stands dismissed.
