Instant application has been filed under Order 47 Rules 1 and 2 read with Section 114 CPC for reviewing the order/judgment dated 13.01.2016 passed in CR-1822-2014.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant and perused the record.

Earlier the property in dispute was owned by Smt. Malti Ram Pandey, mother of petitioner and respondent No.2. As such, if the petitioner remained unrepresented or undefended, his right will be adversely affected and a serious prejudice would be caused to him. The

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order dated 13.01.2016 sought to be reviewed has been passed on merit and following the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Sumtibai and others vs. Paras Finance Co. Mankanwar W/o Parasmal Chordia (D) Ors.* 2007(4) R.C.R. (Civil) 524. It is already observed in the order dated 13.01.2016 that any observations made therein are for the limited purpose of deciding the application for impleading of party and the same will not be taken into consideration for any other purpose and the trial Court shall decide the suit on merit in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the applicant has not been able to make out a case which may warrant review of the order dated 13.01.2016. The civil revision was allowed on merit. Learned counsel for the applicant has failed to show any error apparent on record.

Instant review application is dismissed.
