Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that at the time of dismissal of the writ petition on 13.1.2016, he wrongly conceded that he had been granted 10% extra marks meant for specially Backward Classes. In fact, the applicant had secured 60.41% marks without granting any benefit available to specially Backward Classes. With 60.41% marks, now he is at No. 1 in the waiting list. Shivangi, who was at No. 1, has already been admitted. Seats are still lying vacant.

Considering the stand taken by the applicant in the review application, which is supported by the affidavit, the order dated 13.1.2016 is re-called. The writ petition is restored to its original number and taken on Board.

The review application stands disposed of.
