The review applicants seek to recall the order dated 24.12.2015 passed by the Division Bench (Hemant Gupta.J and Raj Rahul Garg.J) whereby their writ petition was dismissed though with liberty to them to apply for allotment of plot whenever such plots are advertised for the land owners whose land has been acquired. The review application has been filed on the premise that other land owners affected by the same acquisition have been granted effective relief by a Bench headed by one of us (Surya Kant.J) in CWP No.25874 of 2012 decided on 21.10.2013 **(Lovkesh Chander & ors. Versus State of Haryana and ors.)**

The Division Bench in the case in hand though noticed the above cited decision in **Lovkesh Chander's case** but has dismissed the

writ petition, disagreeing with that view.

It may be true that a Coordinate Bench could not have disagreed with the view taken in **Lovkesh Chander's** case(supra) and that too for denying benefits of welfare policy to the affected land owners whose residential structures have been acquired without giving alternate plots to them, but this fact by itself, is not a valid ground for the review of the order dated 24.12.2015. The remedy for the review applicants lies somewhere else.
