Court is of the considered view that present review application deserves to be dismissed as under the guise of present application, learned counsel for the applicants-appellants intends to re-argue the matter by taking the same pleas which were earlier raised by him and dealt-with in the order dated 23.04.2015. Such a view was taken by Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in Dalbir Singh Lochab and others Vs. State of Haryana and others 2014(1) RCR (Civil) 115. More so, the main appeal was partly accepted vide order dated 23.04.2015 after hearing learned counsel for the applicants-appellants.

I do not find any illegality in the order passed by this Court which may warrant any interference in the present review application. Consequently, the Review Application stands dismissed.
