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Earlier, the petitioner-defendant No. 1 had approached this Court for setting aside the ex-parte proceedings as none appeared on behalf of the respondents, this Court set aside the order of ex-parte proceedings subject to costs of ₹ 3,000/- vide order dated 23.2.2016. The petitioner-defendant No. 1 was also given an opportunity to file the written statement. Now the review application has been filed by the applicant-respondent No. 1 on the ground that the petitioner has misled the Court and the application filed by the petitioner was time barred. He further submits that the petition filed at the stage of the plaintiff's examination. Hence, the order be recalled and applicant-respondent No. 1 should be provided an opportunity of hearing before this Court.

I do not find any justification to review the order. The case will be decided on merits. The applicant-respondent No. 1 shall have the right to file the replication to the written statement and shall be allowed to lead evidence.

Application stands dismissed.
