By filing the present application, the applicant seeks review of order dated 22.04.2015 passed by this Court vide which the present appeal was dismissed.

After hearing learned counsel for the applicant, this Court is of the considered view that present review application deserves to be dismissed as under the guise of present application, learned counsel for the applicant intends to re-argue the matter by taking the same pleas which were earlier raised by him and dealt-with in the order dated 22.04.2015. Such a view was taken by Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in **Dalbir Singh Lochab and others Vs. State of Haryana and others 2014(1) RCR (Civil) 115**.
