Applicant seeks review of the order dated 21.01.2013 and also seeks condonation of delay of 623 days in filing the present review application.

It is a matter of record that applicant filed an identical review application bearing RA-CW No.366 of 2013 and the same was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 03.03.2014, which reads as under: -

“Learned counsel for the applicant, at the very outset, fairly states that he does not intend to press the present application and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Ordered accordingly.”

Thereafter, instant review application along with application for condonation of delay was filed, which came up for hearing on 22.12.2014.

Thereafter, as many as 12 adjournments have already been granted either on oral or written request made by learned counsel for the applicant or because of his non-appearance, which is a matter of record.

Today also, case has been taken up twice over. Neither anybody has come present to press the instant review application nor any request for pass over has been made. It seems that learned counsel for the applicant is not interested in pursuing the present review application.

As noticed hereinabove, present one is a second review application, which would not be maintainable. Similarly, no reasonable explanation has been given in the application for condonation of delay of 623 days in filing the review application.

No case for interference has been made out.

In view of the above, application for condonation of delay as well as the review application are dismissed.
