The main case i.e. CRM No. M-15750 of 2015 had been disposed of as infructuous on 21.12.2015 in view of a cancellation report having been filed by the investigating agency. However, at that stage, learned State counsel had submitted that the State is in the process of setting up three Regional Forensic Science Laboratories for analyzing of the samples.

Matter has been put up by the registry in the light of a communication received from the Special Secretary to Govt. of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice disclosing the status with regard to setting up of the three Regional Forensic Science Laboratories and which is as follows:-

“(i) That the State of Punjab had initiated steps for setting up of three Regional Forensic Science Laboratories at Bathinda, Ludhiana and Amritsar. The Laboratories have been made functional.

(ii) That Punjab Public Service Commission as well as Subordinate Staff Selection Board, Mohali have already made recommendations to the posts for which requisition had been sent to them. The appointment letters were sent to the persons

so recommended and selected after the counselling. A total of nine posts amongst the Gazetted Officers were to be recommended by the Punjab Public Service Commission. As against the requisition of nine posts, eight persons have been appointed and one post of Assistant Director remains vacant. As against the requisition of 12 posts being 6 posts of Laboratory Assistants and 6 posts of Laboratory Attendants to be recommended by the Subordinate Staff Selection Board, Mohali, 11 persons have been appointed. One post of Laboratory Assistant remains vacant. In addition thereto, the posts of Computer Operators, Clerks, Peon as well as the Sweepers which were required to be filled up by means of outsourcing have also been filled. (Copy of selected candidates is enclosed). Resultantly, all the 3 new Forensic Science Laboratories to be set up at Bathinda, Amritsar and Ludhiana have become functional.”

In the light of such positive stand taken no further directions are required to be passed in the matter.
