R.A. No. 430 of 2015

The present application has been filed for review of the judgment dated 11.02.2015 passed by this Court. The judgment sought to be reviewed grants the relief of scholarship to the students who were admitted in the degree course by way of lateral entry having done their diploma earlier.

The only argument raised is that diploma holders are not permitted for scholarship as per the policy as such.

It is not disputed that the petitioners have also obtained their degree and, therefore, they are similarly situated as other students who would have joined the degree course and are entitled for scholarship. The denial to students who joined by way of lateral entry would amount to violation of Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

In such circumstances, the judgment sought to be reviewed does not suffer from any infirmity and accordingly, the present review application is dismissed.
