An application for review is filed of a plea that this court while passing the order has not correctly construed the judgment of the Full Bench in Parkash Singh and others Versus Joint Development Commissioner, Punjab and others in CWP No. 2318 of 2002, decided on 08.11.2013. The interpretation of

law or a mistaken inference said to have been brought from the reading of the judgment, could not be a ground for review, for, after hearing the counsel, I do not

find it to be patent error that should be subjected to review. If the judgment impugned is erroneous and does not interpret the law correctly, the applicant will have the benefit of obtaining a correct decision from the Forum where he has right of access by appeal. The application for review is dismissed.
