This is a suit for dissolution of partnership and rendition of accounts having jurisdictional value less than rupees two crores. It is also informed by ld. counsel for plaintiff that the instant suit does not fall within the category of Commercial suits.

It is further submitted by ld. counsel for plaintiff that the partnership deed which is sought to be dissolved by way of the instant suit is situated within the territorial jurisdiction of Central District.
