Without prejudice to the objections of the respondent on the issue of maintainability of the writ petition, this writ petition is disposed of with the consent order that respondent will provide a chart containing detailed calculations under different heads as to what were the amounts payable to the petitioner on account of services of the petitioner's husband as an employee of the respondent and such chart of calculations with the details of the amounts paid will be given to the petitioner/petitioner's counsel within a period of four weeks from today.

2. So far as the relief that petitioner be granted compassionate
