The learned counsel for the respondents submits on instructions that the letter dated 6.11.2015 and the instructions dated 5.7.2015 are under review and the issues raised by the petitioner in the present petition would also be considered particularly with regard to the requirement of having an EPF code in respect of contracts pertaining to repairs and maintenance by contractors employing less than 20 casual workers.

In view of the above, no further directions are necessary in this writ petition. The same stands disposed of.

The final decision be taken by the respondents within eight weeks from today. The petitioner is at liberty to take recourse to such remedies as may be available to it in law in case the decision goes against the petitioner's interests.
