This petition has been filed under Section 14 read with Section 15 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act for appointment of a substitute Arbitrator. It is noted, Hon'ble Mr.Justice C.L.Chaudhary (retired) was appointed an Arbitrator by this Court vide its order dated September 5, 2003.
