This petition challenges the Preliminary Findings 12th November 2015 of the Designated Authority (DA) in relation to the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of 'Purified Terephthalic Acid' (PTA), originating in or exported from China PR, Iran, Indonesia, Malaysia & Taiwan. The Final Findings dated 9th June 2016 have since been rendered by the DA.
3. By a separate order passed today, the Court has declined to entertain Writ
