2. Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in the present case, the petitioner has already paid an amount of Rs.3,00,000/- and ready to pay balance amount of Rs.8,00,000/-, to which the complainant has no objection.

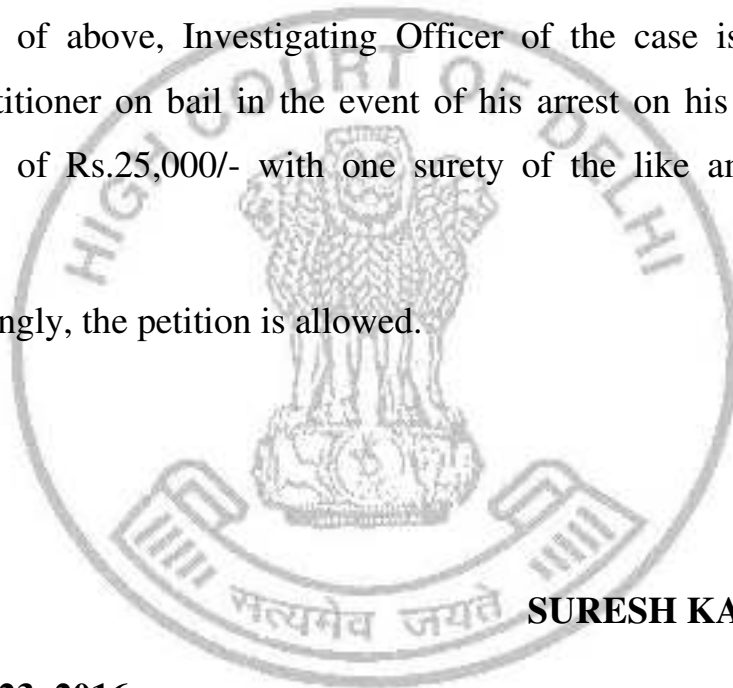
