This is an application under Section 5 of Limitation Act seeking condonation of delay in filing the industrial dispute.

Ms. Neelam Tiwari, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she will file the application for condonation of delay before the Industrial Court along with industrial dispute and does not want to press the present application.

Accordingly, the application is dismissed as not pressed.

C.M. Appl. No.8616/2016

This is an application under Section 151 CPC seeking permission to withdraw the present petition filed on behalf of petitioner with liberty to

raise an industrial dispute.
