1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application stands disposed of.

W.P.(CRL) 650/2016

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.578/2015 under Sections 506/509/34 IPC at Police Station Pandav Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant/victims No. 2 and 3 vide settlement deed dated 10.02.2016.

2. Victims/respondent Nos.2 & 3 are present with their counsel and have been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant/victims if they have settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. They have informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with their free consent and they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 10.02.2016 has been placed on record. Cross case registered vide FIR No.577/2015 registered under Sections 354-A/506/509/34 IPC at Police Station Pandav Nagarr has also been settled and the FIR therein has been quashed. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation, FIR No. 578/2015 under Sections 506/509/34 IPC at Police Station Pandav Nagar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petitioners are directed to deposit ₹ 20,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.

5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
