Mr.Mohit Goel has filed the present petition under Section 34 of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 challenging the impugned award dated 21st January, 2016. Learned counsel for the respondents has raised the objection that Mohit Goel was neither the party to the agreement nor he appeared before the Arbitral Tribunal.
