ORDER

By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 185/2012 under Sections 354/506 IPC registered at PS Malviya Nagar, Delhi on the complaint of respondent No.2 on the ground that the parties have settled the matter.

Petitioner and the Respondent No. 2 are present in Court. The petitioner is identified of his counsel and the respondent No.2/complainant is identified by the Investigating Officer. Respondent No.2 states that she has settled the matter with the petitioner and she does not want to pursue the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto.

In view of the fact that the parties have settled the matter of their own free will, volition and without any coercion and no fruitful purpose will be

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served in continuance of the proceedings, rather the same would create further acrimony between them, it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question.

Consequently, FIR No. 185/2012 under Sections 354/506 IPC registered at PS Malviya Nagar, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.
