ORDER

1. The instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed on behalf of the petitioner for seeking parole for a period of three months. Address of the petitioner has been verified.

2. Nominal Roll dated 09.03.2016 reveals that the petitioner was convicted under Section 376(2)(f) IPC and sentenced to undergo RI for ten years with fine ₹5,000/-. CrI.A.812/2013 was disposed of by this Court on 12.08.2015. Nominal Roll further reveals that the petitioner has already undergone four years, five months and twenty-nine days incarceration besides remission for eight months and twenty-six days as on 09.03.2016. It further reveals that he is not involved in any other criminal case and is not a previous convict. His

overall jail conduct is satisfactory. He has not availed any interim bail or parole during his detention.

3. In the interest of justice and for the reasons mentioned in the writ petition, the petitioner is granted three weeks parole from the date of his release, on furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹25,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/CMM/Duty Magistrate. After completion of parole period, the petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Superintendent.

4. Writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
