Present writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondent no.1-school to charge fee as applicable to the special 60% quota. It has been averred in the writ petition that the petitioners are wards of IRSE Group-A Officers selected through UPSC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that respondent no. 1-school is charging fees as applicable to the General Category Schools from the petitioners, whereas similarly situated wards of persons belonging to IRSE services are paying 30% less fee.

A perusal of the file reveals that the representations made by the petitioners vide e-mails dated 8th September, 2015 (at pages 59-60 of the paper book) and 26th February, 2016 (at pages 72-73 of the paper book) have not been disposed of by respondent no.1 till date.

Consequently, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.1/school to dispose of the aforesaid representations filed by the father of the petitioners within a period of

four weeks by way of a reasoned order.

In the meantime the petitioners, without prejudice to their rights and contentions, shall continue to pay the fees as applicable to the General Category Schools.
