ORDER

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24.05.2016

1. The instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed on behalf of the petitioner for seeking parole for a period of eight weeks. Status report is on record.

2. Nominal Roll dated 20.05.2016 reveals that the petitioner was convicted under Section 376 IPC and sentenced to undergo RI for seven years with fine ₹5,000/-. CrI.A.321/2014 was dismissed by this Court on 02.03.2015. Nominal Roll further reveals that the petitioner has already undergone five years and four days incarceration besides remission for eight months and twelve days as on 20.05.2016. It further reveals that he is not involved in any other criminal case and is not a previous convict. His overall jail conduct is satisfactory. Earlier he was granted interim bail w.e.f. 11.09.2014 to 25.09.2014 and there are no allegations of its misuse.

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3. In the interest of justice and for the reasons mentioned in the writ petition, the petitioner is granted two weeks parole from the date of release, on furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/CMM/Duty Magistrate. After completion of parole period, the petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Superintendent.
4. Writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
5. Order '*dasti.*'
