3. With the consent of learned counsel for parties, instant petition is taken up for disposal.
4. Vide the present petition under Section 482 of the Cr P C, petitioner seeks direction thereby extending the time to deposit a sum of Rs.10.00 Lac within six months in the order dated 17.03.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge while enlarging him on

anticipatory bail in case FIR No.475/2015 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A/406/34 of the IPC at police station Patel Nagar, Delhi.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that petitioner shall make all arrangements and deposit the said amount of Rs.10.00 Lac within four weeks from today.
