1. This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.157/2013 under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC registered at PS Ashok Vihar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 before the Mediation Centre, Rohini Courts, Delhi vide settlement agreement dated 17.10.2013.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present in person and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she is living happily in the matrimonial home for the

last about three years. She has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 17.10.2013 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled and the complainant is residing with petitioner No.1 happily, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to maintain their matrimonial relations, FIR No.157/2013 under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC registered at PS Ashok Vihar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
