1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.195/2008 registered under Sections 498A/406 IPC at PS Dwarka. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.1 vide compromise deed dated 28.04.2014.

2. Complainant / respondent No.1 is present in person and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her

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free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce by mutual consent has already been granted. Pursuant to the settlement, remaining amount of ₹1.30 lac by way of demand draft bearing No.481684 dated 12.11.2016 drawn on Punjab & Sind bank has been given to the complainant in the Court today. Copy of which has been placed on record.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of compromise deed dated 28.04.2014 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.195/2008 registered under Sections 498A/406 IPC at PS Dwarka and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
