1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.171/2016 under Sections 498A/354A/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sarojini Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant/respondent No.4 vide settlement deed dated 07.04.2016.
2. Complainant/respondent No.4 is present with her parents and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from

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the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and they are living together. She has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 07.04.2016 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation, FIR No. 171/2016 under Sections 498A/354A/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sarojini Nagar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petitioners are directed to deposit ₹20,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.

5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
