1. Exemption allowed subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.514/2015 under Sections 498-A/324/354/377/34 IPC registered at Police Station Jagat Puri, East Delhi. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant/respondent No.2 before the Mediation Centre, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi on 19.10.2015.

2. Complainant/respondent No.2 is present in person and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the

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complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the payments pursuant to the settlement have been received by her and all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent. She has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of order dated 19.10.2015 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled before the Mediation Centre and the parties are closely related to each other, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation, FIR No. 514/2015 under Sections 498-A/324/354/377/34 IPC registered at Police Station Jagat Puri, East Delhi and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petitioners are directed to deposit ₹20,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.

5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
