The present is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking a direction in the nature of mandamus to the competent authority to release the petitioner on parole for a period of one month, on medical grounds.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner applied to the Competent Authority of the respondent for grant of parole by way of his application dated 08.04.2016. The said application has not been decided by the Competent Authority so far.

Notice.
