By this application, counsel for the defendant seeks discharge. Along with the application, counsel has annexed copy of the notice sent to the defendant by registered post informing the defendant of the next date fixed in the matter. Despite the said notice, the defendant did not chose to appear either itself or through counsel when the application was listed before the Joint Registrar on 17.12.2015. None appears for the defendant even today. The application is accordingly allowed.
