It is submitted on behalf of the plaintiff that he has no objection if the ex-parte order against the defendants be allowed subject to heavy cost.

In view of the submission and interest of justice, OA is allowed subject to cost of Rs. 25,000/- and the defendants are directed to file their written statement within 30 days from today and rejoinder thereafter within four weeks.
