4. Further, it would be open to the Petitioner to bring to the notice of the Adjudicating Authority the judgment dated 3rd May 2016 of this Court in W.P. (C) 441/2013 *Mangli Impex Ltd v. Union of India* within a period of ten days from today. If that is done, the Adjudicating Authority will give a decision on the question of his jurisdiction not later than four weeks thereafter, after giving the Petitioner an opportunity of being heard.

5. The writ petition is disposed of.
