In view of notification No.1078/G-4/Genl./DHC dated 6th July, 2016 the matters listed for 8th July, 2016 have been taken up today.

Ms. Perna Singh, Advocate who appears today prays for an adjournment on the pretext that the arguing counsel is not available.

It may be noted that on 19th May, 2016 when notice was issued in the present petition Ms. Perna Singh, Advocate addressed arguments.

Learned APP for the State has taken me through the status report.
