CM No. 34854/2016 has been filed for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to file proceedings under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

Mr. Sanghi, learned counsel for the petitioner-applicant prays that the interim protection granted by this Court on 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2016 and 01<sup>st</sup> June, 2016 be extended for a period of two weeks to enable filing of the alternative proceedings.

Mr. Jagjit Singh, learned counsel for the respondents states that this Court has no territorial jurisdiction to entertain the present proceedings.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present writ petition, the present writ petition and
