ORDER

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1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner praying *inter alia* for directions to the respondent-Indian Air Force to decide his representation dated 22nd April, 2016.
2. The petition has been listed before us subject to an office objection raised by the Registry with regard to its maintainability in the High Court.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the present petition while reserving the right of the petitioner to approach the Supreme Court against the order of the Armed Forces Tribunal passed on 24.05.2016.

The order dated 24.02.2016, passed by the Supreme Court and downloaded from the internet and the order dated 24.05.2016, passed by the AFT, handed over by learned counsel for the respondents are taken on record.

6. The petition is disposed of with liberty granted to the petitioner to seek his remedies before the appropriate Forum in accordance with law.
