ORDER

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The petitioners have filed the present petition seeking quashing of FIR No.235/2015 registered on the complaint of the complainant under Sections 498A/ 406/ 34 IPC against the petitioners.

The complainant is present in Court along with her counsel. She is identified by learned counsel.

The petitioner No.1 and the respondent No.2 were married according to Hindu rites on 12.12.2012. Since disputes arose between the parties, they started living separately and respondent No.2 filed her complaint leading to registration of the aforesaid FIR at Police Station – Najafgarh.

The parties have arrived at a settlement on 04.04.2015, which has been placed on record. Under the settlement, the complainant has already received the full settlement amount of Rs.12,50,000/-. The complainant states that she has not been subjected to any pressure or coercion and that she has entered the settlement out of her own free will. The complainant further states that she joins the prayer for quashing of the FIR in question.

Accordingly, no useful purpose would be served in proceeding further with the FIR in question and the proceedings emanating therefrom. The same are hereby quashed.
