1. Issue notice. Learned counsel for the respondent accepts notice.
2. Let the copy of the writ petition be treated as a representation to be considered by the respondent. The respondent shall inspect the petitioner's meter within two weeks and shall afford an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today. The notice of the hearing be given to the petitioners as well as the petitioner's counsel. The respondent shall pass a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of hearing. The speaking order be communicated to the petitioners within a period of two weeks thereafter.
3. The writ petition is disposed of in the above terms. If the petitioners grievance is not redressed, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail

appropriate legal remedies available to the petitioners in accordance with the law.
