By the petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Cr. P.C. in FIR No. 792/2015 under Section 498A/406/34 of IPC registered at Police Station Sagarpur, Delhi.

The main ground for filing the present bail application is that

the application of the petitioner was dismissed in default and non-prosecution and there was no order on the application on the merit of the application.
