By the present petition, the Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 1273/2014 under Sections 354/323/509/506/34 IPC registered at PS Hauz Khas, Delhi on the complaint of Respondent No.2 Ms. Ayesha @ Nagina Khan.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from Investigating Officer states that besides the Petitioners there is no other accused involved in the FIR and besides Respondent No. 2 there is no other complainant/victim.

Respondent No.2 is present in Court and is identified by the Investigating Officer. She states that she has settled the matter with the Petitioners and in terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties, she do not want to pursue the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences of their own free will, volition and without any coercion and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings, rather the same would create further acrimony between them, it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question.

Consequently, FIR No. 1273/2014 under Sections 354/323/509/506/34 IPC registered at PS Hauz Khas, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed subject to each of the petitioner depositing a sum of ₹5000/- each with the Delhi High Court Staff Welfare Fund within two weeks and ₹5000/- each to the respondent No.2 within two weeks.

Parties have signed this order sheet in acknowledgment of their statements made before this Court.

The petition is disposed of. Order dasti.
