The contention of the petitioner is that several applications have been made which are annexed as Annexure – A4 to A6 and despite repeated applications having been made, the respondent has not decided the same.

The writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent to

decide the applications of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks by conducting an appropriate inquiry in accordance with law.

The petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court in case he is aggrieved by the decision on the said applications.
